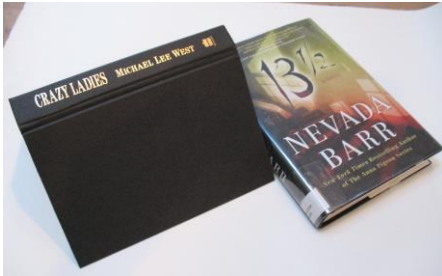


Winter Art Journaling

Supply List

- Hard cover book, from a garage sale or resale shop-Yes the title can help you pick the book, or maybe the size too but keep the page to about 200.



- 1 jar of soft gel medium (gloss or mat doesn't matter Brand- Liquix and Golden)



- 1-roll of clear packing tape generic fine.



- Small sponge roller like for house trim work and some small cosmetic sponges.

- Assortment of brushes, some large and some small for details
- Watercolors, cakes or tubes or pencils
- Pastels pencil or sticks
- Acrylics tubes or bottles
- 1 container for water
- Paper plates for use of a palette, mixing tray or use cool whip lid
- Roll of paper towels
- Tub of baby wipes



- Small container of Gesso- which is a canvas primer



- Magazines, good assortment with images (2)

- Found papers, old letters, postcards, photos, sheet music, old book pages, etc. (skies the limit on what you can use)
- Plastic table cover dollar store works perfect.
- Apron or smock
- 1 roll of Wax paper
- Drafting tape or masking tape
- Scissor
- ruler
- Utility knife
- Pencils and eraser
- Colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener- travel kind is good
- Piece of cardboard or cutting mat- used to slip behind journal pages for cut-outs like doors or windows.
- Rubber stamps, stencils etc.
- Container to carry all your supplies in nicely back and forth to class.
