Susan Fredericks is a professional pianist, composer and filmmaker from Chicago. She was classically trained but augmented her studies to include an immersion in the improvisational medium of jazz.

Her work draws from a myriad of influences including Debussy, Keith Jarrett, Chick Corea, Bartok, McCoy Tyner and Bud Powell. The line is the mainspring from where her compositions arise, the pieces always steeped in the traditions but focused on the beauty of the melody first and foremost, building the foundational harmonies and rhythms accordingly.

She studied classical music extensively with pianist Yasuko Joichi and jazz improvisation with saxophonist Bunky Green, both, her prominent mentors.
